

# INDIANA GYMNASTICS HALL OF FAME

## NATIONAL HONOR AWARD

- A. **Concept:** The National Honor Award is presented to persons who, by excellence of performance, coaching, or judging, have distinguished themselves at the highest level of National and International Gymnastics competition. The Honor Award is presented in person at the annual IGHOF banquet at the Athenaeum facility.
- B. **Criteria:** Selection and award will be based on the following:
1. **National Champion** of an event or all-around in a nationally recognized championship by a constituent organization of USA Gymnastics
  2. **Member or coach** of a National Team who compete against another national team (i.e., USA vs Russia, Maccabee Games, Olympic Team, Pan American Games Team, World Championships Team, etc.). The athlete must compete to be eligible for this award.
  3. **NHSGCA-** All American honors when the award is presented for a 1<sup>st</sup> place National Ranking.
  4. A **coach** of any athlete so identified in # 1, 2 or 3 above.
  5. A **judge** who officiates at an international competition as in #2 above.
  6. **National President of Chairman** of any organization operating a substantial gymnastics activity such as:
    - a. USA Gymnastics National Committee
    - b. USA Gymnastics National Womens Program Committee
    - c. USA Gymnastics National Mens Program Committee
    - d. United States Olympic Committee
    - e. Turners, Sokol, AAU, NCAA, NACGC, NHSGCA, or any constituent organization of USA Gymnastics
  7. **Director or host** for a national level competition held in Indiana, or Hoosiers holding such responsibilities for a national or international competition at any location. The Honor Award goes to the person 'in charge'.
- C. An annual nomination process for the Honor Award, with an appropriate application form, shall be established by the Indiana Gymnastics Hall of Fame committee.
